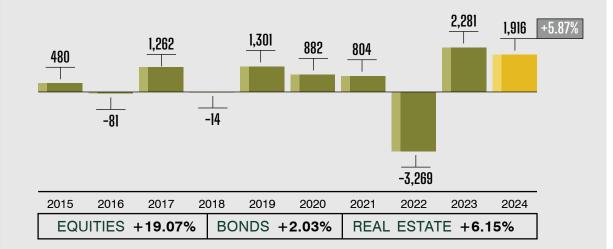

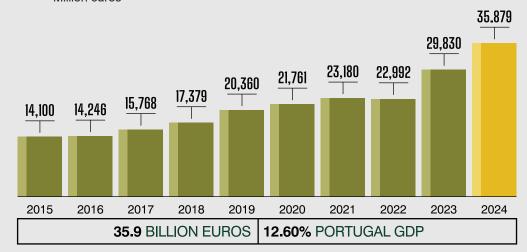

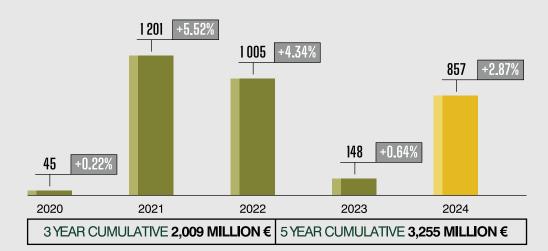
Annual Return Million euros

Year Highlights

Year of Consolidation of Market Recovery:

After a year of significant losses in 2022, 2024 continued the recovery in the markets where the FEFSS invests, which had begun in 2023, highlighting the importance of a patient, long-term investment strategy.

Interest Rates: With inflation more controlled, central banks began lowering interest rates, but with a cautious approach, particularly in the UK and in the US.

Geopolitical Risks: The war in Ukraine continued to affect the European economy. In the Middle East, the conflict between Israel and Hamas escalated, creating instability in oil prices. In the US, the presidential election caused disruptions and uncertainty in the markets. In Europe, political instability exacerbated this uncertainty.

Market Performance: Strong performance of stocks, especially companies in the technology sector associated with Artificial Intelligence. Bond gains were only marginal, not following the reduction in short-term interest rates. In the foreign exchange market, the euro traded relatively stable against the dollar, ending the year at its lowest value since 2022.

FEFSS Value: At the end of 2024, the value of the FEFSS amounted to €35.88 billion, corresponding to a net annual return of +5.87%. Capital inflows reached €4.1 billion, increasing the market value by €6.1 billion compared to the previous year.

Risk Reduction: The risk level decreased from 5.06% in 2023 to 4.40% in 2024, below the 5-year average of 4.99%.

Portfolio Developments: FEFSS continued expanding investments in small-cap stocks and corporate bonds, strengthening the complementary portfolio. By the end of 2024, this portfolio already represented 10.2% of the FEFSS, thus achieving the strategic target allocation.

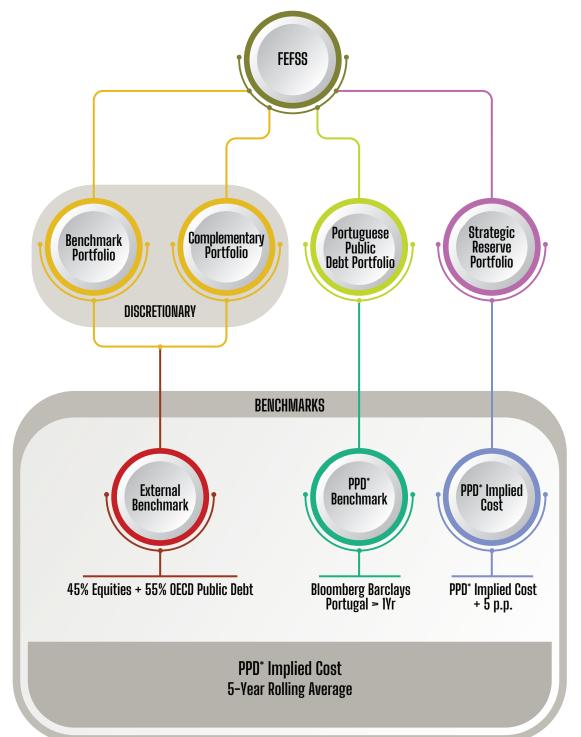

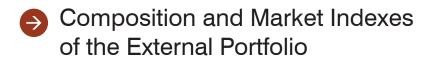

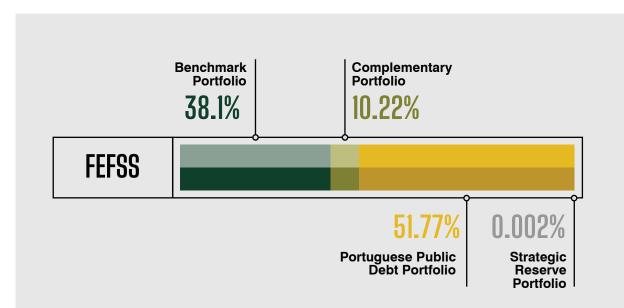

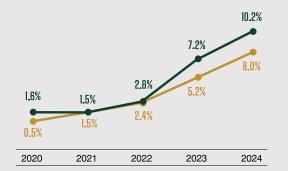


Sub-Portfolio Structure Evolution

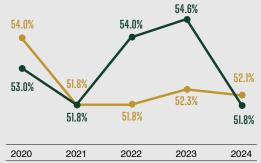

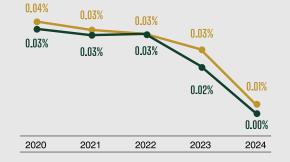




PORTUGUESE PUBLIC **DEBT PORTFOLIO**

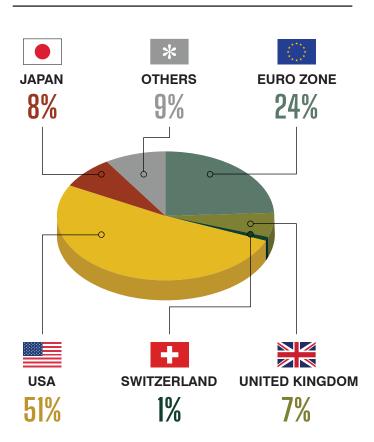

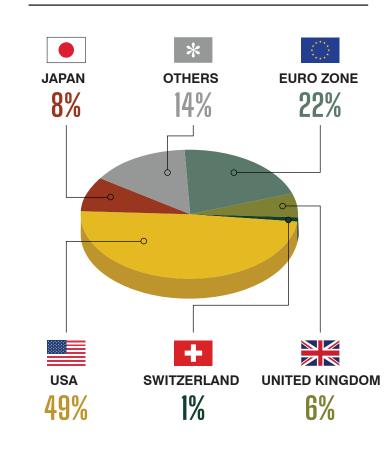

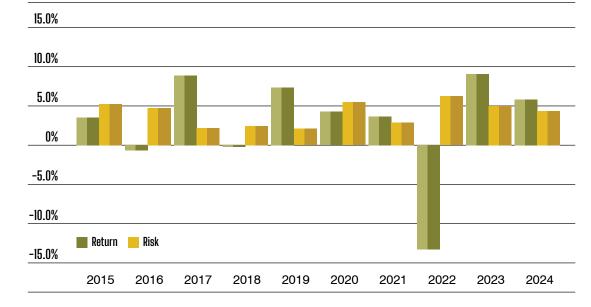

Return and Risk Evolution



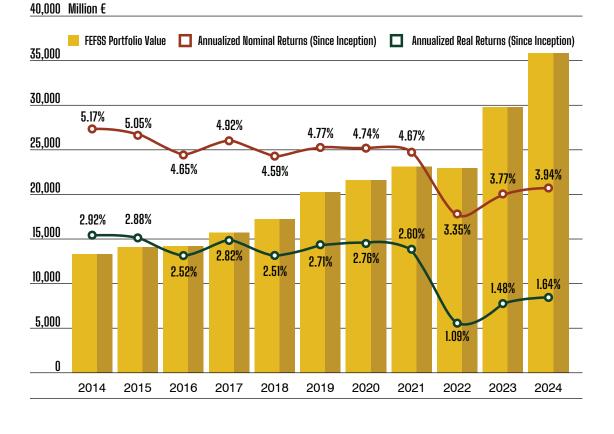


Annual Average Returns

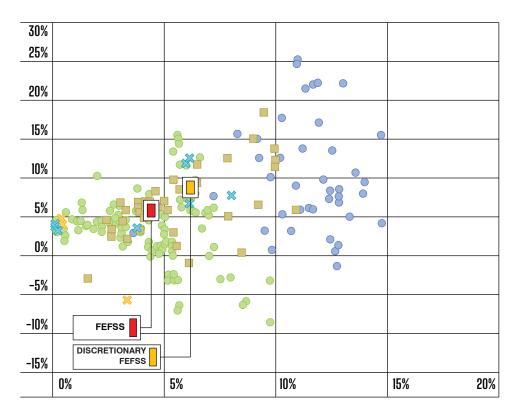

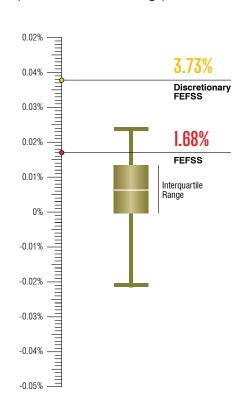
Against International Funds (OECD)

(5 Years — Annual Average)



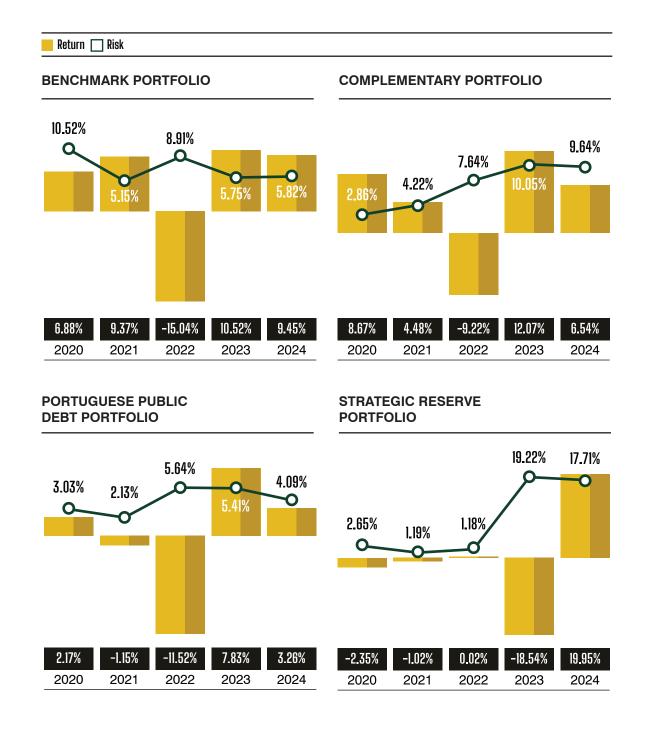

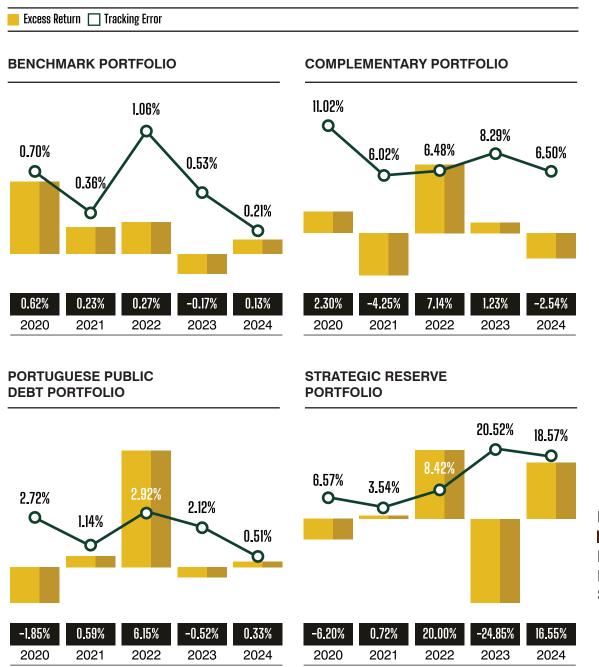

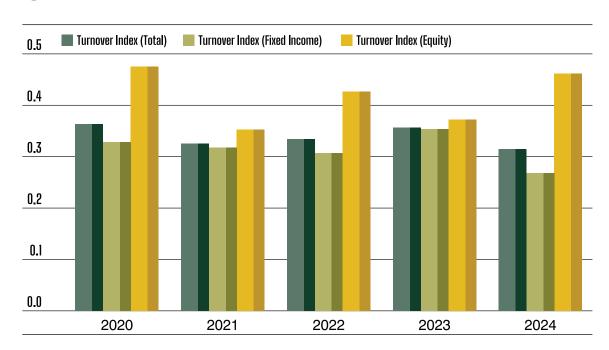

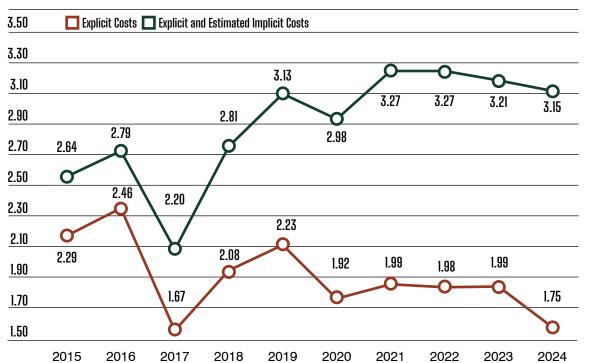

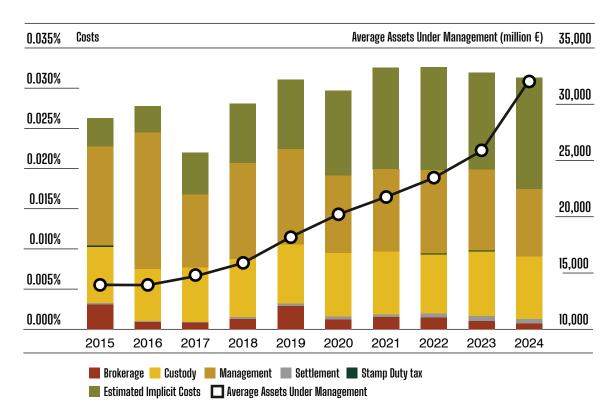

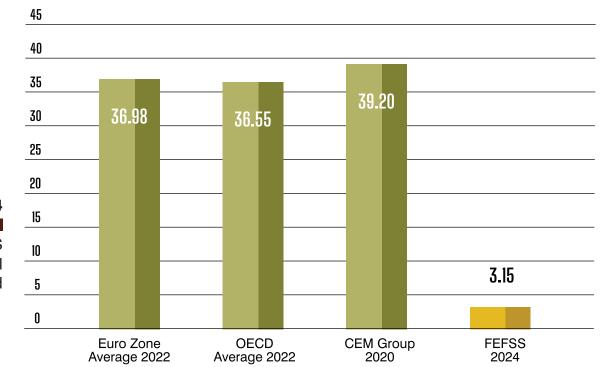

Types of Costs

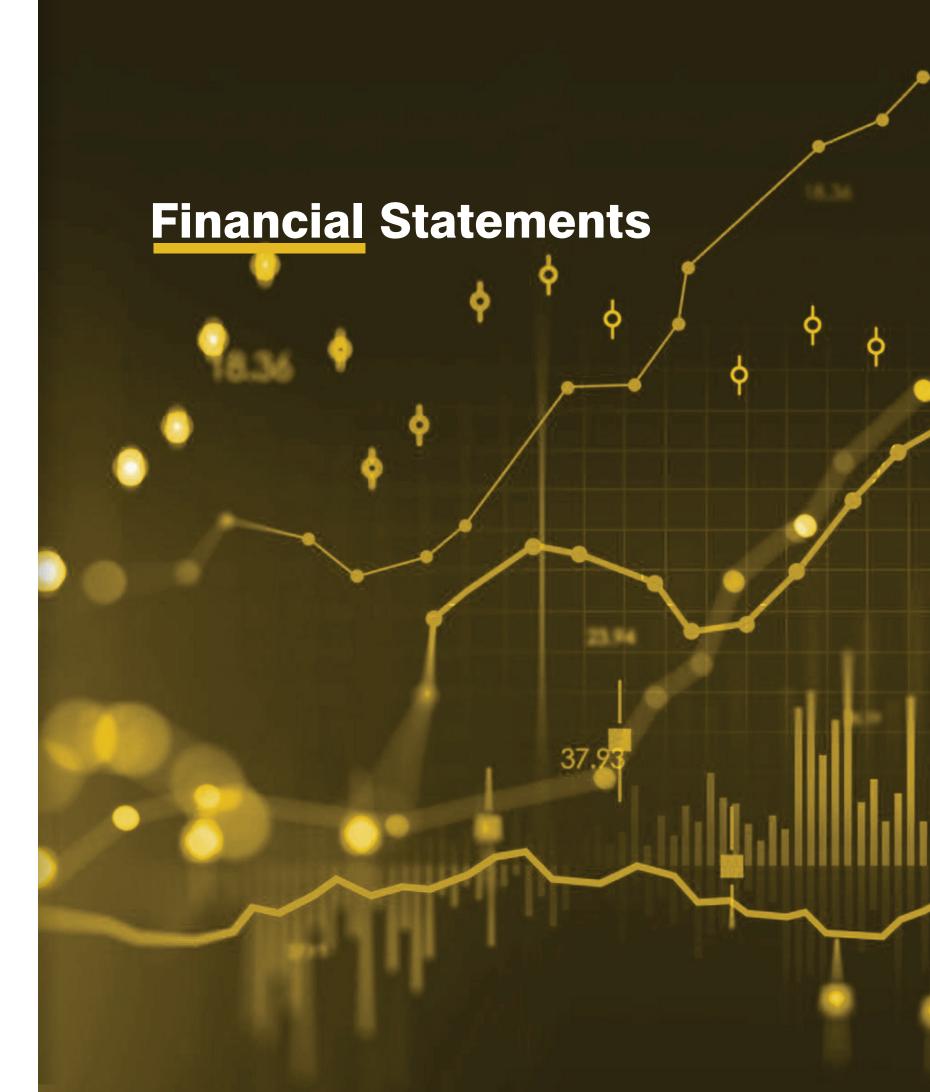


Investment Costs as Percentage of Total Assets (bps)
